

# 1 Prop 205 Causes Major Public Safety Risks

Prop 205 creates the legal right to possess, use, and produce marijuana and hash (a narcotic drug), and allows a two-adult household to grow 1,000s of pounds of marijuana.

Prop 205 prohibits authorities from imposing a THC limit (the mind altering ingredient found in marijuana) for impaired drivers.

Prop 205 prohibits most cities and towns from banning marijuana operations in our communities unlike Colorado's law.

## The Consequences of Prop 205

- In WASHINGTON, according to a recent AAA study, marijuana-related traffic fatalities have doubled since legalization.
- In COLORADO, marijuana-related traffic deaths increased 62% since legalization.
- In OREGON, troopers from around the state reported an increase of 163% in pot DUI arrests in the first six months of legalization.
- Recreational marijuana compromises drug-free workplace policies.

# 2 Prop 205 Endangers Arizona Kids

Prop 205 authorizes the production and sale of highly-concentrated marijuana edibles and candies without limits on potency.

Prop 205 permits sales of marijuana edibles near preschools and youth clubs such as Boys & Girls Clubs.

Prop 205 expands drug use permitting current medical marijuana dispensaries to sell recreational marijuana from the same store front.

Prop 205 allows blatant advertising of marijuana and marijuana products.

## The Consequences of Prop 205

- 45% of the marijuana products sold in Colorado are edibles - accessible and attractive to children.
- In marijuana-friendly states, accidental ingestion by youth has increased more than 600%.
- Legalization means an additional 32,000 Arizonan teens would be more likely to use marijuana for the first time.
- Promises of tax revenues for schools are a farce. "The only thing that the legalization of marijuana has brought to our schools has been marijuana." -Cherry Creek Colorado School Superintendent Harry D. Bull Jr.

# 3 Prop 205 Protects Marijuana Special Interests

Prop 205 uses tax revenue from marijuana sales to create two new government agencies.

Prop 205 stacks the new Marijuana Commission industry representatives to "regulate" their own industry.

Prop 205 is 20 pages of legalese written by out-of-state lobbyists and in-state special interests to guarantee marijuana monopolies.

## The Consequences of Prop 205

- Passage would authorize and protect a new for-profit industry that promotes expanded drug use.
- If you liked Big Tobacco, you will love Big Marijuana's Prop 205 that prioritizes profits over people.
- A select few will get rich while taxpayers pick up the cost of prevention, treatment, accidents and potential in our youth.
- If you don't trust the government to get anything right, why would you trust them to get this right?
