

Scholarship FAQ's

Q. When is the Scholarship Deadline?

- A. Professional Scholarship – April 1st
- Employee Scholarship – April 1st
- Dependent Scholarship – April 1st
- Tuition Reimbursement – Year Round (apply 30 days before the start of class)
- Retail Management Scholarship – Year Round (apply 30 days before the start of class)

Q. How much will I receive for my scholarship?

- A. It is entirely based upon the decisions of the review committee and fundraising from the previous year.

Q. April 1st falls on a weekend; will I still be eligible if the scholarship is received on Monday?

- A. As long as the email, fax or envelope is dated prior to April 1st it will be accepted.

Q. This is my first year in College; do I need to renew my scholarship next year?

- A. Yes, scholarships **must** be renewed every year.

Q. How will I know if I have been selected to receive a scholarship?

- A. You will be notified via US mail by the end of June.

Q. Can I apply for a scholarship and tuition reimbursement?

- A. No, you can apply for one or the other in the same calendar year.

Q. I wasn't eligible for a scholarship; can I still apply for tuition reimbursement?

- A. Only if you are employed by an AFMA member company.

Q. Do I need to submit a letter of recommendation with every application?

- A. If you have been awarded a scholarship or tuition reimbursement, your letter of application will remain on file. Send another letter of recommendation if you feel it will enhance your chances to receive another scholarship.
